ELECTION

Elections will be conducted **by postal ballot, by poll vote** completed by beneficial owners whose names are on the Maori Land Court Register. Voting papers will be posted by 14 September 2026 to registered owners whose addresses are held by the Returning Officer and are on the Pukeroa Share Register.

Voting Papers must be lodged with the Returning Officer by 4pm on Friday, 23 October 2026.

The candidate with the highest polling will be recommended to the Māori Land Court for appointment to the vacancy.
